
Their crisis is real, and it can be the doorway through which they will consider all that Jesus offers.

- 19% of people age18-24 and 21% of adults age 25-34 contemplated suicide in the fall of 20204

Millennials are asking the Question "Where can I find hope?" "Please tell me life will get better" and "Do I matter?" Jesus needs to be at the center of those conversations. He can provide hope, perspective, purpose and value. And, only He can offer forgiveness and eternal life. A Relevant Approach

By saturating the digital media landscape with the message that Jesus cares, we are seeing hearts open to Jesus Christ and lives transformed. In 2020 we saw 116,437 professions of faith in the USA. In just two months (May and June) we saw 2,220 Canadian young adults decide to follow Jesus! Today we are praying to see 10,000 Canadians place their trust in Jesus in 2021.

Our Program is simple:

Use social media commercials to interrupt young adults **INTERRUPT** on their smart phones with a simple message that Jesus cares about them. Communicate the gospel in a relevant and authentic COMMUNICATE way through videos, website, and 24-hour coaching. In addition to listening, loving, and encouraging each COMMIT one who visit the website, our goal is to lead each person toward a commitment to Christ. Offer tools to help new believers grow vertically toward **EDUCATE** Christ and horizontally toward local community. Help to bridge new believers to a local community of CONNECT believers where they can continue on their journey.

The Numbers

Our Canadian test in May and June saw the following results:

- 3,384,641 commercials viewed on Facebook and Instagram
 - 63,777 Canadians visited the jesuscares.com website
 - 2,220 Canadian professions of faith in Jesus Christ

Encouraged by the Canadian test results, we are praying to see **10,000** Canadians respond to the Gospel through a more sustained Jesus Cares Canada campaign in 2021. Based on our experience with JesusCares.com, our goal is to raise **\$237,000** to apply toward content production, advertising, and related expenses to meet that level of outreach.
